ORDINANCE 2020-O 02

AN ORDINANCE REAFFIRMING APPROVAL TO ADJUST WATER RATES

WHEREAS, the Village of Ludlow, Champaign County, State of Illinois (the “Village”) is charged with the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees previously adopted an ordinance relating to water; and

WHEREAS, the Village has conducted various reviews of its water systems and has ascertained that in order to provide a continued level of service and in order to provide for a stable projection of income for future planning it is appropriate and necessary to make various adjustments of water rates. On July 1, 2019 the Village Board of Trustees, by a vote in excess of three quarters of the sitting Board, voted to make certain adjustments to water rates; and

WHEREAS, the Village deems it appropriate to adopt the within Ordinance to reaffirm said adjustments and further make the adjustments as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LUDLOW, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Incorporation Clause.

The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Ludlow hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose.

This Ordinance is to affirm and adjust water rates.

Section 3. Ordinance Adopted.

Water Rates and Charges

A. Effective July 1, 2019 the water rates in the corporate limits of the Village shall be as follows:

For the first 3,000 gallons per month or fraction thereof	\$35.00
For each 100 gallons, or portion thereof, in excess of 3,000 gallons	\$.40

B. Effective July 1, 2019, for users who are not within the corporate limits of the Village, the rates for water usage shall be one and one-half the amount charged users within the corporate limits, subject to negotiation. The Village authorities may determine, in their absolute discrepancy, on the case-by-case basis, whether and on what terms to furnish water to users outside the Village corporate limits.

Bulk Sales

Bulk sales of water for use at a location other than the point of bulk sales designated by the water superintendent. The rate for such bulk sales is \$25.00 per 1,000 gallons of water or any fraction thereof.

Commencing July 1, 2020, and on each one-year anniversary thereafter, the foregoing rate for the first 3,000 gallons per month and the bulk sales rate shall be adjusted to increase by \$10.00 over the then existing rates to arrive at \$55.00 with no further increases thereafter.

Section 4. Superseder and Publication.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded. A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.
